

Sewing items needed for Small business/Sewing Education mission trip to Haiti

We will be bringing a large bag of supplies for each woman in the seminar – enough to start a small business. Deadline for materials February 1.

- Sewing Machines (monetary donations only – we will purchase identical models – Elna 320)
- Sewing machine repair equipment – screwdrivers
- Good quality sewing scissors – 8” (some left handed)
- Small scissors
- Straight pins – glass head (1 ¾”)
- Pin cushion/magnetic pin cushion
- Embroidery hoops – medium size
- Embroidery thread
- Embroidery needles
- Bobbins for Elna 320
- Thread – multiple colors – medium weight
- Fabric – will be used to make tote bags – should be heavier than quilting fabric, but not heavy as upholstery fabric (no stretch knits) – minimum size – at least 16” x 36”
- Sewing machine needles – universal - assorted sizes
- Hand sewing needles
- Needle threaders
- Velcro – sew on only
- Marking chalk
- Snaps – large for tote bags
- Buttons - primarily for decoration, also shirt buttons
- Zippers – assorted length (no invisible please)
- Assorted ribbons, rick rack, and others for decorations
- Patterns: dresses for women and girls, collared shirts for men, women and children, jumpers for girls, slacks for men and boys – please only simple patterns – **Make sure they have directions in FRENCH**
