If you are willing to do any of the items listed, please

**1<sup>st</sup> floor**

- 1) Sanctuary
  - a) Replace broken storm windows
  - b) Front doors
    - i) Difficult to open and close
    - ii) Varnish is coming off – needs to be sanded and resealed
- 2) Near lift
  - a) Repair wall
  - b) Repaint wall
- 3) Going up the stairs toward balcony
  - a) Repair wall
  - b) Repaint wall

**2<sup>nd</sup> Floor**

- 4) Kim's room
  - a) Check out leak above window

**Outside**

- 1) **Fellowship Hall (Outside)**
  - a) paint soffit (sand, prime then paint?)
  - b) Paint trim around windows where there is bare wood (sand, prime then paint?)
  - c) look into replacing cement under door closest to the glass door
  - d) look at soffit outside kitchen – I think there is a split in it (repair, sand, prime then paint)
- 2) Entrance (side glass door)
  - a) Replace ice melt wires – broken
  - b) Clean out gutter
  - c) Remove “tree” from roof
  - d) Remove tree from guttering near 2<sup>nd</sup> floor
- 3) Replace the Bilco Door leading down into the boiler room
- 4) Power wash sidewalk to remove moss growing
- 5) Remove plant growth(moss?) from side of building with reserved parking signs
- 6) Check the sump pump outside the food pantry to see if it is still working
- 7) Replace cover on outside outlet (outside Food Pantry where sump pump is plugged in)
- 8) Sand, prime and paint metal railings in walkway and at the front of the church
- 9) Check sign in front – sand, prime and repaint
